
FES Virtual Learning

Expectations for Students/Parents:

- Students will commit to virtual learning for the entire quarter.
- Students and parents are expected to return communication with contact teachers in a timely manner. Teachers may not be immediately available but will reply in a timely manner.
- Student attendance is determined by regular and active participation and student meeting course goals.
- Students are expected to meet regular goals set by teachers:
 - JK-8: Complete 30 minutes per class per day
- Additional interventions may be used for students not meeting assigned goals.
- Maintain communication with the Virtual Learning teachers.
- Have access to Infinite campus to check on student grades.

Expectations for Contact Teachers:

- Contact teachers will:
 - Serve as primary contact for assigned students: ask and answer questions, connect students to resources, communicate concerns, etc.
 - Attempt a minimum of 2 contacts to each student and/or student's parents each week. Teachers will follow up on any unreturned/delayed communication. All communications should be logged.
 - Return communication with students and parents in a timely manner.
 - Communicate weekly goals to students.
 - Monitor student progress in all courses.
 - Schedule and unlock student tests/quizzes as needed.
 - Report any concerns.

Tips for Edgenuity Users:

- The program works best using the Chrome browser.
- Access the Help Center for tutorials and FAQs by clicking the down arrow by the Hello message in the upper right-hand corner of the login page.
- Students may send messages to contact teachers directly through Edgenuity by using the mail feature, although it is preferred that messages be sent directly to the contact teacher using K12 mail.
- It is highly recommended that students take and keep notes as they progress through each course.
