Dear Parents/Guardians:

Flandreau Public Schools will offer driver's education classes again this summer. The cost of the class is \$240.00 with checks made payable to Flandreau Public Schools. This fee is non-refundable, unless the minimum number of participants is not met. Fees will not be refunded if the participant does not show up for class or driving times.

To meet state law guidelines, each student must attend thirty hours of classroom instruction and drive six hours behind-the-wheel. Students must be 13 years of age by January 1st, 2022, to be eligible for this class. There are limited spots open and will be determined by age. Unfortunately, scheduling constraints cannot allow for any absences. There will be no make-up hours available if a student misses a class period. All school rules and policies will be in effect during driver's education.

Classroom instruction will begin on Tuesday, May 31st and will finish on Thursday, June 9th. Please note that the schedule is subject to change, depending on the school board's approval for the last day of school for students. We will notify all those involved if there are any changes. Wylie Scalise will be instructing the classroom portion as well as the driving portion. Below is the schedule currently planned for the classroom instruction:
