For art projects don't worry about the quality of the supplies used to create the artwork. If all you have for paper is lined paper from a notebook or the back of an advertisement. That is fine, recycle, reuse and be creative!

Artworks that are drawings and painting please hang on to them so that you can bring them to school or upload an image of the artwork and send it to me. Either way if you can take a photo of the artwork I would really appreciate having one, especially if it's a sculptural piece built from legos, toys, or found objects. ☺

<p><u><a href="#">Create a page or a series of pages to depict things that you are thankful for.</a></u></p>	<p>Use one page/board per "thing" or one page/board for all "things", or many boards/pages for one "thing". You decide.</p> <p>Use any art media or mixed media. Choose from: pencil, color pencils, pen, pen and ink, markers, watercolors or acrylics, collage, etc...</p> <p>Use typography as a part of the design. <p><u><a href="#">Create a personal visual diary.</a></u></p>	<p>Record each day as a whole, or the most important aspect of that day, or the most memorable part or anything you felt was important.</p> <p>All days should be executed in the same style, color scheme, and art medium.</p> <p>Steps</p> <p>1. Reflect on your day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What did you do today?</li><li>• How did you feel today?</li><li>• Whom did you meet today?</li><li>• What happened in the world, country, town, school today?</li><li>• What was the weather like? Did it affect your day?</li><li>• How was your family today?</li><li>• Were you busy or lazy?</li><li>• Did you go shopping? What did you buy?</li><li>• What did you watch or listen to?</li></ul>

	<p>2. Pick one event that you think can describe your day.</p> <p>Record that event and illustrate it (sketch). Make sure to include the date.</p> <p>Each Day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Illustrate this event by sketching an image that would describe it. The image itself should convey the message.</li> <li>• You can add a few words if need to (as a part of the design)...</li> <li>• Use one to three words for the caption (below the design).</li> <li>• Incorporate a date into design.</li> <li>• Decide on colors and style to represent a happy day, a boring day, or a sad day...</li> <li>• Use colors in your design.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Create temporary sculptures with household items or nature.</u></p>	<p>Photograph, and use them as a drawing inspiration. Complete one sculpture. One drawing.
